BYLAW NO. 1/2004

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A FEE TO APPEAL ASSESSMENTS TO THE BOARD OF REVISIONS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Persons desiring to appeal their assessment to the Board of Revisions for the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 shall file their appeal in the form prescribed in *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989*.
- 2. A fee in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) shall accompany the form, or shall be paid to the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 within 30 days of the notice of assessment being published in the Saskatchewan Gazette pursuant to subsection 301(1) of *The Rural Municipality Act*, 1989.
- 3. Where the appellant is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the board of revision or the appeal board, the Rural Municipality shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant to the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91.
- 4. Where an appellant fails to pay the fee pursuant to Section 2 of this bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed.
