BYLAW NO. 06/2019

A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINNG CONTRACTORS AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include any person firm or corporation.
- 2. Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the municipality, shall before undertaking well-drilling in the municipality, pay the municipality the following license fee:
 - a. For the Drilling of an oil well or gas well \$450.00.
 - b. For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information \$225.00.
- 3. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall productand exhibit his license when require to do so by the license inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
- 4. The well license fee shall be submitted with the development permit.
- 5. Any contractor found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
- 6. Bylaw No. 10/2003 dated November 13, 2003, is hereby repealed.
