BYLAW NO. 06/2019

A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINING CONTRACTORS AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the word “contractor” shall include any person firm or corporation.
2. Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the municipality, shall before undertaking well-drilling in the municipality, pay the municipality the following license fee:
 - a. For the Drilling of an oil well or gas well \$450.00.
 - b. For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information \$225.00.
3. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when require to do so by the license inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
4. The well license fee shall be submitted with the development permit.
5. Any contractor found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 10/2003 dated November 13, 2003, is hereby repealed.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:



SCHEDULE "A" BYLAW NO 08/2019

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made the ___7th_ day of _November___, 2019 A.D.

Between: The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, of the Province of Saskatchewan
 AND
 The Village of Maryfield, of the Province of Saskatchewan

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to exchange services/assets related to the operation of the village and the rural municipality

IT IS HEREBY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

1. The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 shall provide snow removal, summer maintenance and mowing on the following:
 - a. One mile of Grid 600 located in the Village of Maryfield.
2. The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 shall have the right to determine what maintenance will be performed on the road as well as the timeline it will be performed on.
3. The costs of gravel shall be billed to the Village of Maryfield.
4. It is understood that this agreement will be continuous, and shall be reviewed by the parties to the agreement annually. This agreement may be terminated by either party to the agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing.


