And

WHEREAS On call wages for Emergency Medical Responder personnel is less than half of minimum wage and time spent on-call time does not count towards any benefits for Emergency Medical Services personnel.

SARM lobby the Provincial Government to provide easier access for training opportunities for those willing to take the Emergency Medical Responders or Primary Care Paramedic course.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that

SARM lobby the Provincial Government to have better on call wages and benefits to help people of the communities have a better opportunity to get involved in turn helping with staffing shortages."

**A BYLAW TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
THE VILLAGE OF MARYFIELD TO JOINTLY
FUND AND/OR EXCHANGE SERVICES**


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw, and identified as Schedule "A" with the Village of Maryfield.
2. The Village of Maryfield and the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 agree to jointly fund services and/or exchange services related to the operation of the Village of Maryfield and the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91.
3. The Reeve and Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Schedule "A" herebefore referred to and attached hereto.
4. Bylaw No. 08/2019 dated November 7, 2019, is hereby repealed.





SCHEDULE "A" BYLAW NO 02/2020

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made the 13th day of January, 2020 A.D.

Between: The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91, of the Province of Saskatchewan
AND
The Village of Maryfield, of the Province of Saskatchewan

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to exchange services/assets related to the operation of the village and the rural municipality

IT IS HEREBY UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:


1. The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 shall provide all maintenance on the following:
 - a. One mile of Grid 600 located in the Village of Maryfield.
2. The Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 shall have the right to determine what maintenance that will be performed, at the expense of the R.M. of Maryfield No. 91.
3. The Village of Maryfield shall be invoiced for gravel only, delivery shall be considered part of maintenance, at the current rate payer price. This rate shall be reviewed annually.
4. It is understood that this agreement will be continuous, and shall be reviewed by the parties to the agreement annually. This agreement may be terminated by either party to the agreement by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing.

BYLAW NO. 01/2020

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Maryfield No. 91.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression, extrication and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service as follows:
 - First hour - \$1,250.00
 - Additional Hours or part thereof - \$800.00 per hour
 - Minimum Call Out Charge - \$500.00
 - Plus consumables and damages to equipment.
3. The Council authorizes the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
4. That this bylaw come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
